For an example: I would be watching something violent on TV and I would have it turned up loud and when they came home I would get one of those looks and they would go off into their rooms and close the doors and just to spite them I would turn it up louder. Or I would be talking on the phone engaged in a very ungodly conversation and I would get those grins you no what I mean? I'm pretty sure they didn't even know they were doing it but I saw it and it was starting to worry me a little because it felt like they didn't want to be around me. I was getting so many of these kinds of looks I started to dislike the things that were unpleasing to my family. But the thing that got me the most was the loneliness. Because they were going to church on Saturdays I was enjoying the free time I had to myself by hunting and fishing but when I got home nobody was home, there was a note that said we will be home late because we're at a vespers. I thought

when you went to church you went on Sunday and only for an hour or two but this was Saturday and they were gone all day and all evening. So I was feeling left out even though they invited me every time. On Sunday they did some ministry work in the middle of the day so it was kind of hard to plan anything with them. On Wednesday they went to bible study in the evening and when I got home from work they were getting ready to go and by the time they got home I was already in bed. Friday they went to choir practice and worship in the evening and Saturday it started all over again.

I love my family and doing things with them but they were not interested in the things I liked to do anymore. You know Laura would be talking on the phone and I would hear sister so and so or brother so and so and that was a blessing or thank you Jesus. I would think to myself what is going on here I need to find out what it is there up to. The next time they invite me to one of their functions I'm going to go. Next vesper Briana asked if I wanted to go and I said yes and you should have seen the joy on their faces. So I went and I was a little nerves because I thought for sure I was going to get some of those strange looks at the sinner husband, but it was nothing like that at all these people were loving and

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caring and treated me like they knew me forever. They had a worship service and sang songs and gave testimonies of how Jesus blessed them that week and they played bible games. I felt very comfortable and I was feeling much better about what my wife and daughter were doing. From time to time I would go along with them to a fellowship but I still didn't want to go to church. I didn't want to do anymore than what I was doing but the Holy Spirit had another plan.

I have a daughter from a previous marriage who lives in Indiana and because of the broken marriage our relationship is not great. We planned for her to visit for a week but the only time she could come was when Laura's church planned to have a week of prayer. I decided that was ok the prayer meetings were only a couple hours long and while Laura and Briana went to the prayer meetings Stacey and I would have that time to get to know each other better. I'm thankful for Laura and Briana they always made Stacey feel at home. It was a very comfortable setting except when her and I were alone things are different. The past is very hard for us to talk about. She is 29 now and we separated when she was 1 1/2 and we still have a relationship problem. So when it came time for Laura and

Briana to go to the prayer meetings you could tell we didn't want to be alone with each other so even though we didn't want to go to a prayer meeting we decided to go. It was those prayer meetings that changed my life. All the people's prayers, testimonies, scripture reading about Jesus and how Jesus changed their lives and can forgive sins made me want to get to know this Jesus more. Every night we learned more about how to pray so our prayers would be heard and it was all taken straight out of the Bible it was quite an experience and that was the start of my relationship with the Savior. I know those prayer meetings worked on Stacey as well but we're still having some problems so if you can remember please pray for us. I am so thankful for prayer.

Galatians 5:19–21

<sup>19</sup> Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are *these*; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, <sup>20</sup> Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, <sup>21</sup> Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told *you* in time past, that

they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.

## **But look at verse 7:**

<sup>7</sup> But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.

Proverbs 28:13

He that covereth his sins shall not prosper:
But whose confesseth and forsaketh *them* shall have mercy.

If you've read anything of church history you probably heard about the great evangelist, Dr. Finney. His revival meetings were so powerful that he was known to go into a town and by the time the meetings were over they closed every bar in town for lack of patrons. Dr. Finney held a meeting somewhere back east and when he was walking up the stairs to the church a man called out to him and asked him if he could meet with him after the meeting and Dr. Finney yes I'll meet with you. So when he got to the top of the stairs the Deacons of the church asked him, "What did that man want"? Dr, Finney said, "he wants to talk to me after the meetings" and the Deacons said, "Do you know who that man is"? Dr. Finney said, "No". They said, "That man is the worst man in town, he has killed people and he probably has it in for you. You're not going to meet him are you"? Dr. Finney

said, "Yes I am, I gave the man my word". So after the meeting the man was waiting for him and he lead him down the street into a dark ally and to a door where he opened the door and said, "Go in" and he locked the door behind him and he sat at a desk in front of him and opened it and pulled out a gun and said, "Sit down". And he said, "I heard you say something the other night and I want to know if it's true". Dr. Finney said, "Well what did you hear me say"? He said, "You said the blood of Jesus Christ God's Son can cleanse a man from all sin". Dr. Finney said, "No, I didn't say that, God said it in His word". He said, "Wait a minute you don't know what I've done. You are behind a bar with an illegal gambling casino and the machines are fixed and I've taken the last dollar from many people and they've gone out and committed suicide, you mean God can forgive me for that"? Finney said, "All I can tell you is the bible says, the blood of Jesus Christ God's Son can cleanse a man from all sin". He said, "Wait a minute that's not the whole story, I own the bar out in front and men will come in and drink and their wives will come in rags with their children and beg me not to sell their husbands booze and I throw them out on the street and when their husbands run out of money I throw them out on the street, you mean God can forgive a man like that"? He said, The bible says that the blood of Jesus Christ Gods son can cleanse a man from all sin". He said, "wait a minute you don't know the full story, this gun has killed many men that have gotten in my way, I've hired men to kill other men, you mean God can forgive me"? Finney said, "All I can tell you is that the bible says all sin". He said, "wait a minute, across the street in that big brown stone house and I have a wife and a beautiful little girl and I haven't said a decent word to my wife in over 16 years, I've been miserable I've been mean. The other day when my little girl ran up to me I pushed her away and she fell against the stove and was burned seriously. I've never told that little girl I love her. YOU MEAN GOD CAN FORGIVE ME! And at this point Finney stood up and he grabbed him and began to shake him and he said, "Young man you have told me just about as horrible of a story I've ever heard or could dream and I don't know if I could forgive you but the bible says the blood of Jesus Christ God's Son can cleanses a man from all sin". He

said, "That's all I wanted to know, thank you, you could go and he went over to the door and unlocked it and said you can find your way from here.

The next morning as the sun was coming up, he was walking from the bar over to his home and he came into the house and his wife was in the kitchen with his daughter and he went on up stairs. The mother said to her daughter, "Go upstairs and tell your daddy breakfast is ready". So the little girl went half way up the stairs and said, "Daddy, momma said breakfast is ready". And he answered, "Sweetheart tell you mommy, daddy doesn't want any breakfast this morning". So she ran down stairs and said, "Mommy, mommy, daddy said he didn't want any breakfast and he called me sweetheart". And the mother said, "Honey you must of misunderstood, go back up stairs and tell daddy breakfast is ready". So she went back up the stairs and said, "Daddy momma said breakfast is ready". And he said, "Come here honey". So she went over to him and he picked her up and put her on his lap and began to tell her how much he loved her. Well the mother was wondering what was going on and followed her daughter up the stair and saw him holding his little girl on his lap for the first time with tears running down his cheek and he said, "Come over here honey", he said, "I found out something last night that is the greatest thing I have ever heard and it's true".
