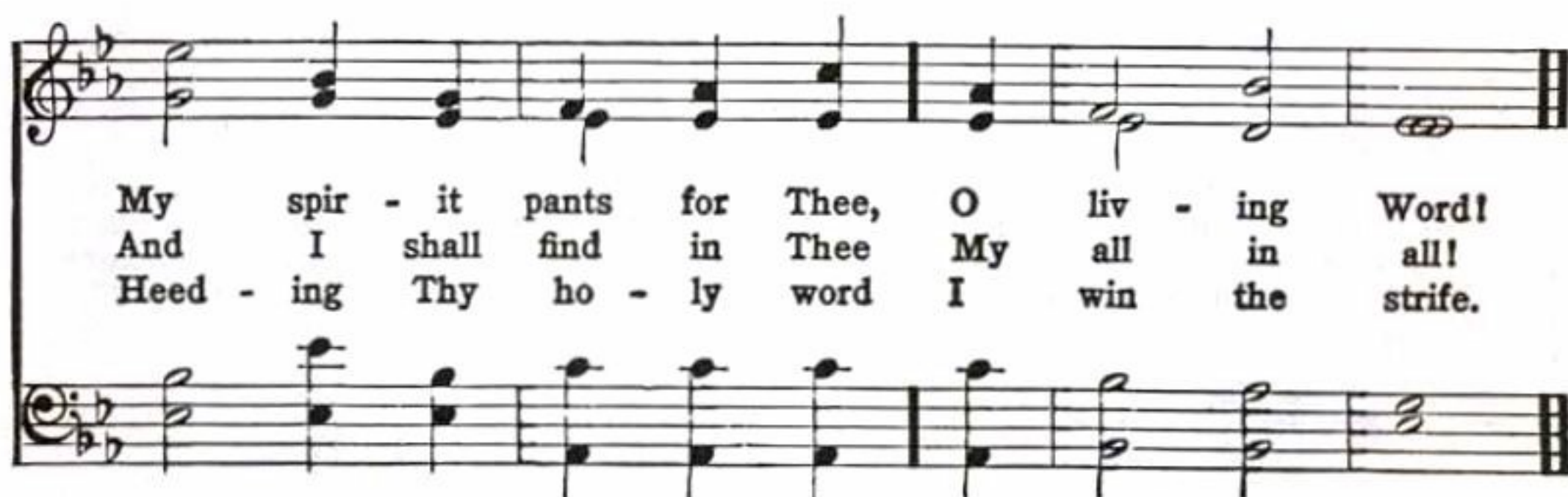
1. Break Thou the bread of life, Dear Lord, to me,
