
Dear Brother Short:

Mr. Altman informs me that a booking has been made for you and family for Mombasa on October 27. These bookings are difficult to get, and so we have authorized this one for you although the problem that lies before us with reference to the manuscript that you and Brother Wieland are preparing has not yet been fully settled. Brother Wieland informs me he will have the manuscript in our hands some time next week, and then our Committee will meet here in Washington to determine just what procedure to take. However, after consultation with Brother Olson and other members of the Committee, we feel that you should definitely plan to accept this booking back to Africa preparing to enter upon your work there as soon as possible. I am, therefore, notifying Brother Altman today clearing the way for you to return to the field, although the official action of our Committee will not be taken until some time next week after we receive the manuscript.

I trust, Brother Short, that the Lord will richly bless you as you look forward to another term of service in Africa. We have appreciated your sacrificial service in the past, and we want to assure you our prayers will go with you as you go out to that needy field where there is so much to be done, and so few workers.
