Although as authors of this document we believe its basic thesis to be true and we have not retracted our positions, yet it must be clearly understood that we consider that the form of its presentation not suitable for general publication nor was it written for publication in the first instance. We cannot judge nor condemn any loyal Soventh-day Adventist for following his own conscience, but we wish to state that we have nothing to do with the publication of this document which we have consistently left to the disposition of Providence, through the regular channels of the organized church, to be dealt with as an overruling Providence shall direct.
